As you may be aware from our earlier circulars, the Administrators of the former trustee of the LM Managed Performance Fund (**the Fund**) hold a claim over the assets of the Fund for work undertaken predominately prior to the appointment of KordaMentha Pty Ltd and Calibre Capital Limited (collectively **the Current Trustees**). This position has been referred to as the Administrators Lien in 'Update 10' and was discussed in that update.

On Friday, 29 November 2013 the Current Trustees and the Administrators of the former trustee attended a mediation to resolve the value of their claim. At the mediation an amount was agreed.

In order to finalise the matter, all parties have agreed to apply to the Supreme Court of Queensland for ratification of the settlement. Accordingly, we hereby give you notice of the application for the Approval of Settlement Agreement and have made the Originating Application available on our website: <http://www.kordamentha.com/creditor-information/australia/109>. All supporting documentation filed by the Current Trustees will be uploaded to this website as it becomes available.

We refer to the above.

Section 96 of the *Trusts Act 1973* (Qld) provides that a trustee's application for directions pursuant to that section '*shall be served upon... all persons interested in the application or such of them as the court thinks expedient*'.

The members of the MPF are persons interested in the application. The originating application and material in the application must therefore be served on them.

There are approximately 4500 members of the MPF, most of whom live overseas. It is neither practicable nor (in our view) necessary for each member to be personally served. It is appropriate, in our clients' view, that the court make orders for substituted service of the application and supporting material on the members.

Our clients have already made the application and the affidavit of Simon Michael Vertullo sworn 13 December 2013 available on the website maintained by them for the provision of information to the members. Emails have been sent to the most recent email addresses held by our clients for the members notifying them of this. We are instructed to seek orders from the court that this mechanism will suffice for substituted service of the application and supporting material.

Obviously the substituted service orders will need to be obtained before the application can proceed. We therefore propose that the hearing tomorrow be used to seek these orders. We **enclose** an Application proposed to be filed by

leave tomorrow and a draft order for substituted service and request that you confirm whether your clients will consent to the court making orders in this form.

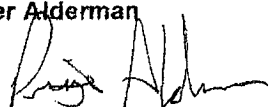
Our clients' position is that there should be no order made as to your clients' costs for tomorrow, as is contemplated by clause 9 of the binding Heads of Settlement entered into between the parties on 29 November 2013, by which your clients agreed that they would meet their own costs of this application.

On 12 December 2013 we sent an email to your office setting out certain material which our clients proposed to include in their affidavit material in support of the application. You responded to our email the same day. While both emails were marked 'without prejudice', this was due to references they contained to events during the mediation held between the parties on a without prejudice basis on 29 November 2013. The references in this letter are to the non-privileged settlement agreement which resulted from those negotiations, and are therefore not subject to any privilege. This letter is written on an open basis.

Your email indicated that the handwritten 'Heads of Settlement' and the draft settlement deed should be confidential exhibits to our clients' material. While our clients do not consider that there is any requirement of confidentiality in relation to the terms of settlement, we were instructed to accede to your clients' request in order to avoid any dispute about this issue at the hearing of the application. As there is no effective way to maintain the confidentiality of material once it has been posted on the website, our clients have not yet provided the members with access to this material.

We understand that as of this morning your clients may not require that either of these documents, or the terms of settlement, be kept confidential. Please confirm that our understanding of your clients' position is correct so that our clients can give the members notice of this material and make it available to them on the website.
