OUTLINE OF SUBMISSIONS ON BEHALF OF THE VARIOUS REPRESENTATIVE DEFENDANTS

- These submissions are made in each of the above proceedings on behalf
 of the various representative defendants (appellants in the Almond Land
 Rights Appeal Proceeding) appointed in the various proceedings
 (Representative Growers).
- 2. A summary of the Representative Growers and the capacity or capacities in which they each appear is contained in Schedule 1 to these submissions.
- 3. These submissions address the following issues:
 - (a) the process undertaken to obtain instructions to accept the proposed settlement;
 - (b) responses to material filed in opposition to the settlement that is directed towards the Representative Growers and those who act on their behalf;
 - (c) comments or objections received from the represented parties.

4. To avoid unnecessary duplication, these submissions do not address the issues to be taken into account by the Court when considering whether to approve the settlement as we understand that this will be comprehensively addressed in the Banks' submissions.

Confidentiality application

- 5. Schedule 2 to these submissions sets out the confidential exhibits filed by the Representative Growers. They consist of:
 - (a) privileged and confidential advice to the Representative Growers (copies of which have been supplied to represented parties on request and subject to an appropriate undertaking); and
 - (b) call sheets of correspondence from represented parties(summaries of which have been provided in Ms Armstrong's affidavit material).
- 6. An application for confidentiality was foreshadowed in Ms Armstrong's affidavit material. We anticipate that minutes of consent can be filed before the hearing.

Process undertaken to obtain instructions

- 7. The process undertaken to obtain instructions to agree to the settlement is set out in the affidavits of Celia Jane Armstrong filed in the various proceedings.
- 8. Schedule 3 of these submissions sets out the relevant paragraphs of Ms Armstrong's affidavits filed in the various proceedings.
- 9. In summary, the process undertaken is as follows:
 - (a) copies of our advice were circulated to each of the representative defendants in each proceeding;
 - (b) on 20 July 2012, a meeting was held at Clarendon Lawyers' office to discuss the advice and any questions about the advice. Six

- Representative Growers attended in person, two by telephone and four were unable to attend:
- (c) the Representative Growers in attendance at the meeting, both in person and by telephone, there and then gave instructions to accept the offer;
- (d) the Representative Growers who were unable to attend the meeting subsequently provided instructions to accept the offer;
- (e) the updated version of our advice was provided by email to the Representative Defendants;
- (f) on 29 August 2012 our supplementary memorandum of advice was provided to the Representative Growers by email; and
- (g) on 1 October 2012 a further supplementary note will be sent to the Representative Growers and those who had requested copies of the advice previously.

Response to Ms Bezencon's material

- 10. An affidavit dated 18 September 2012 in opposition to the settlement was filed by Kerree Anne Bezencon. The vast majority of that material is objected to as inadmissible.
- 11. The fourth affidavit of Celia Jane Armstrong filed in the Solora Rights
 Proceeding responds to Ms Bezencon's affidavit. A copy of that affidavit is
 exhibited to Ms Armstrong's fourth affidavit in each of the BB Olives and
 Fenceport Proceedings.
- 12. In summary, Ms Armstrong gives evidence of:
 - (a) the extensive involvement of Clarendon Lawyers and the
 Timbercorp Growers Group in litigation following the insolvency of
 the Timbercorp Group;

- (b) steps taken to keep Ms Bezencon and organizations associated with her informed of developments in the various proceedings (see paragraphs 14, 18, 21 and 33-40 of Ms Armstrong's fourth affidavit);
- (c) Ms Bezencon having been involved in numerous legal proceedings relating to the Timbercorp managed investment schemes, including:
 - making various complaints about the bidding process and applying unsuccessfully to appoint a temporary responsible entity to the Almond Land Almond Projects (see paragraphs 10-11 of Ms Armstrong's fourth affidavit);
 - ii. unsuccessfully applying to be appointed as representative defendants in the Almond Land Rights Proceeding (see paragraphs 12-13 of Ms Armstrong's fourth affidavit); and
 - iii. unsuccessfully applying for a representative nominated by her organisation to be appointed as representative defendant in the Solora Rights Proceeding (see exhibit CJA-22 to Ms Armstrong's fourth affidavit at pp 25-31);
- (d) Clarendon Lawyers having received instructions to accept the settlement offer from each of the Representative Defendants (see paragraphs 25-29 of Ms Armstrong's fourth affidavit); and
- (e) unanswered requests made to Ms Bezencon for information (see paragraphs 30-31 of and exhibit CJA-26 to Ms Armstrong's fourth affidavit).
- 13. We are instructed that, at the date of this outline:
 - (a) Clarendon Lawyers has attempted to contact each of the
 Representative Growers in the five rights proceedings to obtain
 affidavits from them to confirm that they were acting

- independently of Mr Garnaut when giving instructions to accept the settlement offer:
- (b) Clarendon Lawyers has received confirmation from David Sydney Butterfield, Goran Runje, Robert Bugden, Michael Charles Vicary, Christopher Mark Littley, Shun King Li, Pauline Emma Hammer and Graham Goldenberg that they will swear affidavits in this regard;
- (c) Celia Jane Armstrong of Clarendon Lawyers is prepared to swear an affidavit deposing to:
 - i. instructions received from Constantine Moshopoulos and Graham Dace who are both away and will be unable to give affidavits themselves; and
 - ii. instructions received from Graeme Cole that he is prepared to give an affidavit but may not be able to do so in time;
- (d) Both Celia Armstrong and Alexandra Gleed of Clarendon Lawyers have attempted to telephone Pamela Jan Dry but have not received a response; and
- (e) appropriate affidavit material will be filed to confirm those instructions as soon as possible.

Outstanding costs

- 14. There are orders in each proceeding other than the Almond Land Rights Appeal Proceeding that the Representative Growers be paid their costs from the relevant Fund on provision of a certificate from an agreed independent costs consultant.
- 15. We are instructed by Clarendon Lawyers that:
 - (a) there are costs outstanding in all proceedings other than the Almond Land Rights Appeal Proceeding;

- (b) the agreed independent costs consultant has recently indicated that she now has capacity to attend to the outstanding costs certificates whereas previously she was occupied on other matters;
- (c) bills and files for the outstanding amounts will be provided to her shortly; and
- (d) affidavit material will be filed shortly to confirm those instructions.
- 16. If a certificate of costs cannot be obtained by the hearing of this matter, it is submitted that the orders in this matter will need to allow for the payment of the outstanding amounts. Submissions will be made at the hearing as to the appropriate way to resolve that issue.
