- 3 Except where I otherwise indicate, I make this affidavit from my own knowledge. Where I depose to matters from information and belief, I believe those matters to be true.
- I have previously sworn an affidavit in this proceeding on 27 March 2014 (**My First Affidavit**). I defined a number of terms in My First Affidavit and I adopt those definitions in this affidavit.

- Since My First Affidavit, the Timbercorp Grower Management Team have continued to monitor the Hotline and the Grower Email Facility and to complete Communications Reports in accordance with the Agreed Protocol. I am informed by Ms Moodie that, on 11 April 2014 a completed Communications Report was emailed by her to Macpherson + Kelley Lawyers and a further completed Communications Report was emailed by her to Arnold Bloch Leibler on 6 May 2014.
- 8 I am informed by Jing Chang of Arnold Bloch Leibler that on 6 May 2014, she emailed Macpherson + Kelley Lawyers the completed Communications Report sent by Ms Moodie on 6 May 2014.
- A copy of the Communications Report for the period from 24 March 2014 to 10 April 2014 is exhibited to the Third Affidavit of Yu-chiao Hsueh affirmed on 17 April 2014 at confidential exhibit **YCH-7**.

- 12 I am informed by Ms Moodie that, in relation to those remaining 10 Growers which the Timbercorp Grower Management Team followed up:
  - one Grower was contacted by phone and the Short Letter to Growers and First Notice to Growers was sent to the postal address provided by the Grower;
  - (b) eight Growers were sent the Short Letter to Growers and First Notice to Growers by an alternate email and none of these emails "bounced back"; and
  - (c) in relation to one Grower who had declared bankruptcy, the Short Letter to Growers and First Notice to Growers was sent to the Grower's trustee in bankruptcy by email.
