Dear Michael & Clint

I am sure that you are aware of the outcome of the meeting by this time. It was attended by KM and ABL as well as a number of growers. There were considerable proxies voted in favour of a both resolutions. These proxies were given to a number of people who attended that meeting.

However, as a matter of courtesy, I inform you of the following:

- (1) It was decided prior to the meeting (and after discussion with Robert Costa) that the opportunity to conclude a transaction between Align and Costa should be given every opportunity to be finalised;
- (2) That the RE role would not be changed on Tuesday 9/11;
- (3) That, if the proposed agreement should not proceed for whatever reason, the existing growers should have a right to be involved in the future direction;
- (4) At the meeting, disclosure was made of your letters/emails, previous correspondence with ABL and you and other matters of relevance regarding offers for he property and of the fact that you will not provide us with a copy of the Crop Sale Deed you so often refer to;
- (5) The meeting decided to change the RE but effective from 22/11 so that your transaction can be concluded;
- (6) Each project voted for the removal of KM and appointment of FABAL. There was over 75% and 85% (respectively) in favour of the change of RE;
- (7) Minutes are being finalised at this time and we may provide you a copy if you require them for select purposes only.

As we have previously discussed, FABAL is seeking to work with all parties and not against them. We will not enter into costly legal battles that hurt growers. Our actions on Tuesday are a further indication of this stance.

We look forward to being notified by 19/11 on whether the transaction is proceeding or not so that we can represent the growers in the appropriate matter.
