- I, CELIA JANE ARMSTRONG of Level 17, Rialto North Tower, 525 Collins Street, Melbourne, make oath and say that:
- I am an employee of the firm Clarendon Lawyers Pty Ltd, the solicitors for the the Representative Growers in the Timbercorp Rights Proceedings. Subject to the supervision of my principal, Michael Fernon, I have the carriage of this matter on behalf of the Representative Growers and I am authorised to make this affidavit on their behalf.
- Except where otherwise indicated, I make this affidavit from my own knowledge. Where I depose to matters from information or belief, I believe those matters to be true.
- I am making this affidavit in respect of each of the following Supreme Court of Victoria Proceedings:
 - (a) S APCI 2011 0103 (Almond Land Rights Appeal Proceeding);
 - (b) S CI 2011 6777 (Fenceport Rights Proceeding);
 - (c) S Cl 2011 6604 (Liparoo & Yungera Rights Proceeding);
 - (d) S Cl 2011 6606 (Solora Rights Proceeding); and
 - (e) S CI 2010 1354 (BB Olives Rights Proceeding),

together the Timbercorp Rights Proceedings.

I have submitted a number of affidavits in each of the Timbercorp Rights Proceedings which I refer to in the affidavit as my **Earlier Affidavits**. Defined terms in those affidavits have the same meaning in this affidavit unless I state otherwise.

Additional Grower Emails

- On 19 September 2012 I swore an affidavit in each of the Timbercorp Rights Proceedings (namely, the Third Affidavit of Celia Jane Armstrong). In that affidavit I described the Grower Notification and Consultation Process and summarised the results of that process as at the 17 September 2012.
- On 2 October 2012 I swore another affidavit in each of the Timbercorp Rights Proceedings (namely the Fourth Affidavit of Celia Jane Armstrong in respect of the Almond Land Rights Appeal Proceeding and Liparoo & Yungera Rights Proceeding and the Fifth Affidavit of Celia Jane Armstrong in respect of the other Timbercorp Rights Proceedings). In this affidavit I described the further results of the Grower Notification and Consultation Process and updated my summaries of that process as at 26 September 2012.
- On 3 October 2012 Ms Kerree Bezencon (Ms Bezencon) provided me with approximately 75 emails that had been sent to her regarding the proposal to compromise each of the Timbercorp Rights Proceedings. Ms Bezencon provided the majority of these emails in hard copy after the conclusion of the first day of the hearing of the approval applications in each of the Timbercorp Rights Proceedings and she emailed some others to me later that evening. Now produced and shown to me marked CJA-A is a true copy of the bundle of these emails (Additional Grower Emails).
- I have reviewed the Additional Grower Emails and set out below a summary of the contents of those emails:
 - (a) One (1) of the emails was sent on behalf of five separate people and entities.
 - (b) Four (4) emails contained no text other than the author's name and only showed that author had replied to an email sent by Ms Bezencon requesting a reply.
 - (c) Two (2) emails requested further information.
 - (d) Sixty nine (69) emails expressed an objection or otherwise expressly or impliedly supported Ms Bezencon. Forty-four (44) of these emails included one or more comments of the kind summarised in paragraph 9 below.
- 9 The following comments are made in the Additional Grower Emails:
 - (a) six (6) comments about being disgruntled with TSL and the management of Timbercorp;
 - (b) two (2) comments about being disgruntled with the Court;
 - (c) ten (10) comments about being disgruntled with KordaMentha;
 - (d) three (3) comments about being disgruntled with the Banks;
 - (e) two (2) comments about being disgruntled with ASIC;
 - (f) fourteen (14) comments about the settlement offer being too low;
 - (g) six (6) comments about the growers not being involved enough in the process or being treated badly;



- (h) five (5) comments that the growers interests were worth more or that the schemes were viable or the assets were sold for too low a price;
- (i) four (4) comments about the banks getting priority over the grower or that corporate interests generally prevailed over the interests of growers;
- (j) one (1) question about how the settlement figure was reached;
- (k) eight (8) comments about the unfairness of Timbercorp loans;
- (I) nine (9) comments about the injustice of the whole matter.
- I have compared the list of authors of the Additional Grower Emails against the names of growers who are listed in the Communication Spreadsheets and Further Communication Spreadsheets. The following authors of the Additional Grower Emails have also contacted the TSL and their enquiries, comments or objections to TSL or me have been recorded in my Earlier Affidavits:
 - (a) Ms Knol contacted TSL on 14 August 2012 and requested a copy of the First Notice to Growers. She did not lodge any objection with TSL and did not expressly notify Ms Bezencon of any objection.
 - (b) Ms Lauricella notified TSL of her objection on 14 August 2012 and repeated her objection to Ms Bezencon.
 - (c) Mr Randle contacted TSL on 15 August 2012 and requested a copy of the First Notice to Growers. He did not expressly lodge an objection with TSL or Ms Bezencon.
 - (d) Mr Thorne contacted TSL on 15 August 2012 and requested a copy of the First Notice to Growers but lodged no objection. He informed Ms Bezencon of his objection in his email to her.
 - (e) Ms Tenekatizis contacted TSL on 16 August 2012 and requested a copy of the First Notice to Growers. She did not lodge any objection with TSL, however, she informed Ms Bezencon of her objection in her email to Ms Bezencon.
 - (f) Mr Webb contacted TSL on 16 August to ask if he had any loans with Timbercorp. He did not lodge any objection with TSL and did not expressly lodged an objection with Ms Bezencon.
 - (g) Mr King contacted TSL on 16 August 2012 and requested a copy of the First Notice to Growers. He did not expressly lodge an objection with TSL or Ms Bezencon.
 - (h) Mr Crilly returned bank account nomination forms to TSL on 16 August 2012. He did not expressly lodge an objection with TSL but expressed his support of Ms Bezencon in his email to her.
 - (i) Mr Rao contacted TSL on 20 August 2012 and requested a copy of the First Notice to Growers. He did not lodge any objection with TSL, however, he informed Ms Bezencon of his objection in his email to Ms Bezencon.
 - (j) Mr Jones contacted TSL on 20 August with questions about his debts to TSL and fees due to TSL. His call was escalated and I subsequently spoke with Mr Jones. He did not lodge an objection with TSL or me; however, he notified Ms Bezencon of his objection in his email to her.

Thank you for your email acknowledging and recording my objection to the deed of compromise. You will need to excuse my emotions, but as explained to Ishbel Jorgensen, I firmly believe that the 5% of the proceeds of the sale that has been offered to pay the growers can only be described as an insult and I fail to comprehend how any fair minded person could consider those recommending the offer be accepted are considering "the best interests of the growers"; frankly I see the offer as nothing more than opportunistic and unconscionable and those making the offer taking advantage of those that have already lost a lot and in a position of weakness.... my sentiments go out to those who have borrowed money and are now faced with the prospect of being forced to settle a loan with no tangible return.

It would be unreasonable not to expect an element of risk with any investment, but as is evident with the failure of Timbercorp, Forest Enterprises Australia and Great Southern Plantations, but to name a few, those who invested in these Managed Investment Schemes were ordained to lose their money – the grower investors have, indeed, been comprehensively deceived and no one has been held to account; and what is more galling is the perpetuation of the deception by those appointed to protect the interests of the growers, namely Korda Mentha - the Responsible Entity.....I cannot believe the conflict of interest has permitted to continue to the extent that it has - this is truly an

To date, it has not been satisfactorily explained how the offer of 5% was arrived at, but in my opinion, it seems the intrinsic value of the plantations, orchards and groves, which the growers paid to have planted and nurtured has been totally ignored; indeed, I would venture to say that without the existence of the plantations, groves and orchards on the land that has been sold, the sale of the land would never have occurred; and, let's face it, those who bought the land assets are not property developers about to clear the land they've purchased!

Celia, I could continue ad infinitum with my protestation of the entire process, but any self respecting person would not accept the offer, and I do not; if I have a choice, I would rather spend the proceeds paying lawyers to negotiate a better deal in this way if the banks are going to get their way they will have to fight for it.

In closing, I welcome any further updates.

Not sure what specific offer we are objecting to or in what format you want the objections. Would however, like to make some comments on how disadvantaged and unfairly treated we are.

- 1. The split of the Olive Projects proceeds comes up on 3 October 2012. My understanding is all the Projects were sold to Boundary Bend for \$59m. Soon thereafter, Boundary Bend sold the water rights for \$50m giving them a "net" cost of \$9m. You have to question whether the sale process was properly conducted.
- 2. As an investor in the 2001 Olive Project, I was paying my annual management fees and using the harvest proceeds to pay down a loan from Timbercorp Securities. At no time did I think that this arrangement would be undone and the business taken away. I'm now left with the loan on which

interest is still being charged at the original rate. The security for the loan ie my interest in the 2001 Olive Project has now been realised and I'm left with a loan on which there is recourse (something that was never highlighted when the loan was taken out). The commercial reality at the time would

have been that Timbercorp Securities would be quite satisfied to lend to the investor at the high interest rates as the investor was paying the management fees to maintain their interest in the project; harvest proceeds were coming in and the loan was secured over the investors project interest.

Given these insecurities, the loan should not have been a recourse loan. These loans should be written off by the liquidator.

3. I could go on, but with the track record of Fighting Funds, Class Actions, John Garnaut, McPerson and Kelley etc., I have little confidence.






