Timbercorp Citrus and Table Grape Projects

At the hearing before Justice Judd on 24 November 2009, we mentioned to the Court the Liquidators' intention to amend the Constitutions for each of:

- 1 2004 Timbercorp Citrus Project;
- 2 2005 Timbercorp Citrus Project;
- 3 2004 Timbercorp Table Grape Project; and
- 4 2005 Timbercorp Table Grape Project,

to include a power to surrender the Growers' Sub-leases. As Mr Zwier Indicated to the Court, given that the amendments are the same as those made in the case of the Timbercorp Forestry, Almond and Olive Projects, the Liquidators' view is that the amendments are not controversial. Accordingly, unless an objection is made by ASIC or the grower representative group, the Liquidators do not intend to seek a direction in relation to the making of the amendment. However, as has been the case with each other Timbercorp Project, the Liquidators would seek directions from the Court prior to exercising any such power.

Please let us know if you have any issues with us amending the Constitutions in this manner.
